It's spring and Lolli Pup is so excited to be rescued from the streets and in a foster home. When she was found, she didn't have any medical issues; she just needed to be spayed and vaccinated and since she is as social and well mannered as can be, she was clearly not a long term stray. But like many animals found on the streets that are basically healthy and friendly, she had no means of identification.

HPPL provides both an ID tag (you can see Lolli's) and a microchip for every animal, cat or dog that enrolls in the foster / adoption program. Please remind friends and family (and maybe even yourself) that microchips save lives. Nearly every shelter and clinic has a scanner in case a pet is loose. When Lolli finds her forever home, she will be registered and will never be unidentified again.
