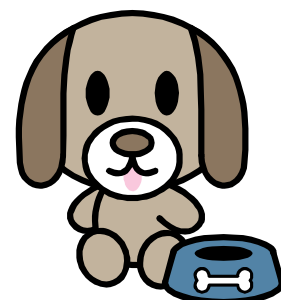
HAPPY ENDINGS
