Dear Friend,

Hard to believe that the year is more than half over, and as usual in summer months, HPPL receives numerous pleas for help with kittens. They are definitely cute and cuddly, but as we all know, there are just too many animals in our city that have no home. When finders will foster, we help. In addition, to try to stem this furry tide, HPPL continues to underwrite free cat spaying and neutering for community/feral cats as well as for owners who are on public assistance.

Thus far, in 2014, HPPL has provided funding for 264 cats to receive surgery and vaccinations. Our next Fix a Feline for Free surgery date is in late August when we hope to alter another 55 to 60 cats. If you know of caretakers needing assistance with spaying/neutering their kitties, please contact HPPL.
