After many gray, gloomy and chilly days, we are all looking forward to some sunshine in our lives. But no one is looking for brighter times more than Humphrey.

When he arrived at HPPL intake, Humphrey could stand for only a few minutes (that's why he is lying down in the picture). He was so weak that standing was too much of an effort. After an initial examination by the veterinarian, it was clear that this guy had serious medical concerns.

Not only was Humphrey completely malnourished so that the rib bones were showing, but he had the highest level of heartworms

possible and he had bite wounds on his face that needed immediate care. So off, he went to the full service clinic for blood work and much needed medications to boost and heal his system. A month later, Humphrey is doing better. He was severely anemic and had an elevated white count from infections. HPPL
