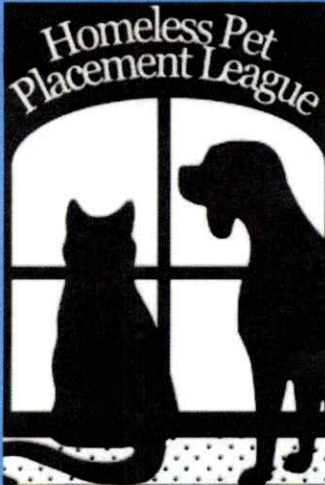

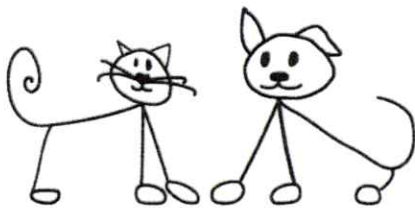

Meet **Rey**, Rey was born in July 2023 and her foster mom describes her as a little shy. Like her siblings, she is loving and enjoys a good play session.

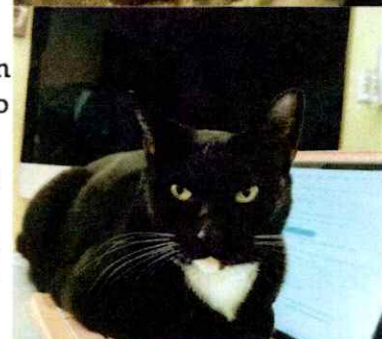
